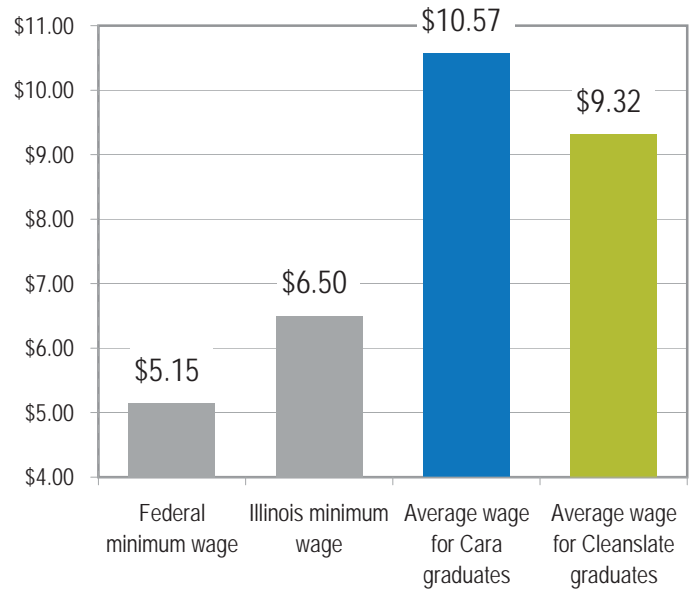
The Cara Program assists motivated homeless and impoverished individuals to transform their lives and achieve real, lasting success.

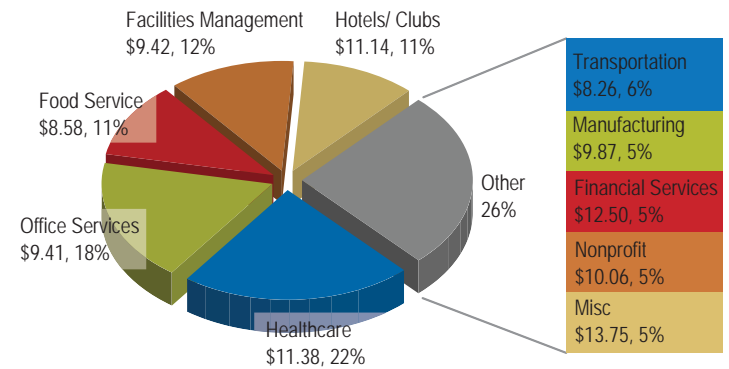

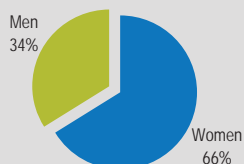

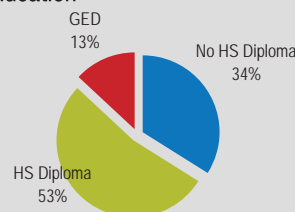
Gender



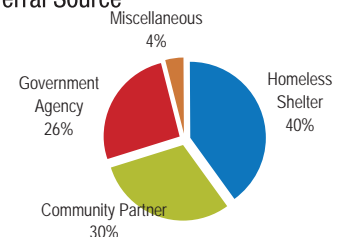
Criminal Record

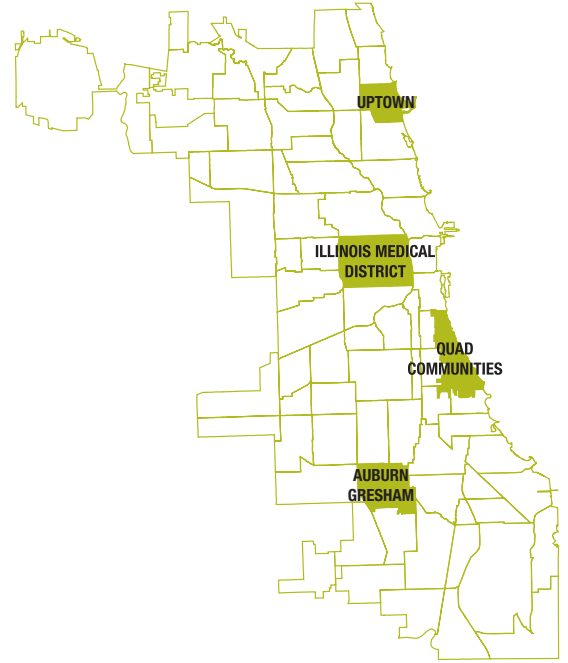
CLEANSLATE MISSION

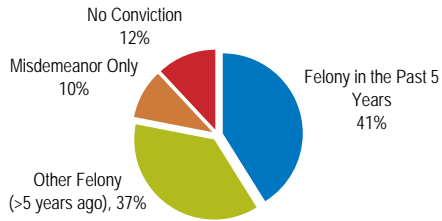

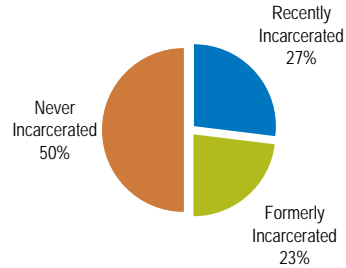
